Declaration under Section 21 of the Firearms Act 1968

It is an offence for a person who is prohibited under Section 21 of the Firearms Act 1968 to have a firearm or ammunition in his/her possession at any time.

This Section applies to any person who has been sentenced to imprisonment or to youth custody or detention in any young offenders’ institution for three months or more. It also applies to a person who has been sentenced to imprisonment of three months or more where the sentence is suspended.

- A person sentenced to a period of imprisonment of 3 months or more, but less than 3 years is prohibited for 5 years from the date of release.
- A person sentenced to 3 years imprisonment or more is prohibited for life.
- A person sentenced to 3 months imprisonment or more where the sentence is suspended is prohibited for a period of five years beginning with the second day after which the sentence is passed.

It is an offence for a person to transfer, let, hire, or lend a firearm or ammunition to someone whom he knows or has reasonable grounds for believing to be a prohibited person.

I hereby declare that I have never had a firearm or shotgun application refused or such a certificate revoked. I also declare that I am not a person prohibited by virtue of Section 21 of the Firearms Act 1968.

I, the undersigned, agree that the information shown above is correct. If elected to membership, I undertake to abide by the Constitution and Byelaws of the Club and understand that my personal data may be held and used solely for the purposes of conformance with the legal requirements of membership of an approved rifle club.

Probationary Membership

Applicants may visit the club for a trial session free of charge. After which they must apply for probationary membership before subsequent visits.

A £5.00 Range Fee will be payable for each visit AND the first box of 50 .22 RF rounds will be provided free of charge. Any ammunition used thereafter will be charged at the Club rate. ALL AMMUNITION MUST BE STORED SECURELY AT THE CLUB UNTIL SUCH TIME AS A FIREARM CERTIFICATE IS GRANTED TO THE APPLICANT.

The Committee of the Club wishes to make clear to applicants that it is Club policy that a probationary period is to be completed before full membership of the club is established. This period will be as decreed by the Home Secretary at the time of application, or at the discretion of the Committee.

It is also to be understood that Club Rules and instructions given by an RCO are to be followed. Any misconduct can result in membership being terminated.

It is required by law that an Applicant's name and address is forwarded to the Norfolk Constabulary Firearm Section for record purposes.

All Club members must sign the register recording their personal activities in respect of the use of firearms, when using the range.
